

An introduction to working with loss and bereavement

The loss of a significant other through death as well as having to come to terms with our own mortality are perhaps the only universal human experiences. It is these phenomena that have for centuries fascinated and frightened us. The threat or actual loss of a significant other can have a profound impact on our wellbeing and can, as some commentators have argued, lead to long-term psychological problems. Most of us need time and support from those around us in order to find a new sense of being in the world.

For people with learning disabilities the story can be much more complex. Both bereavement and disability are complex issues in our society so when they come together it can make it very difficult for us to think and act appropriately.

This seminar aims to address how we can improve support for both adults and children with learning disabilities who are facing mortality issues or who are grieving.

This seminar will focus on how Respond works with adults and young people experiencing loss and bereavement:

- We will explore how best to support adults and children with learning disabilities, their families and the people that work with them
- We will look at the impact that working with loss and bereavement can have on all
 of us
