What's unique about it?

- Partnership approach to teaching where the adult 'guides' the child's learning rather than telling him what to do, ensuring the child shares participation, reciprocates with the adult and understands the meaning and purpose of each activity
- Step-by-step approach - helping the children become aware of their abilities to self-regulate, followed by learning about when and where they need to use these skills and then learning to become more resilient to distractions
- Incorporates mindfulness, or the ability to remain calm and centered in the 'here and now' which reduces anxiety and improves attention
- Teaches children to be explicitly aware of their actions, thinking, and emotions
