

How to use the pack

This pack is designed to be used as a **Communication Tool**. It aims to provide support in meeting the information needs of people with communication difficulties. This could be someone with a learning disability, a young carer, a person who does not use English as a first language or someone with neurological problems.

The **Tools to use with the pack** section contains a group of resources that can be used with almost all of the sections within the folder. They should be used as an interactive communication tool to find out how the client is feeling, if they are in any pain and if so, where the pain is. The 'days of the week' calendar can be used for appointments and can be photocopied.

The **Communication Chain** section aims to highlight aspects that should be considered when giving information to people who have communication difficulties.

The **Health Promotion Pack** focuses on cancer prevention and aims to increase cancer awareness and the uptake of screening activity.

The **Cancer Journey Pack** focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of cancer. Some sections of the pack are supported with *guidance notes for health professionals* which give more detailed information about the specific subject area.
