There is a constantly growing body of peer reviewed research which supports the use of Intensive Interaction to promote social engagement and assist learners with complex communication disabilities to acquire the fundamentals of communication. The purpose of this training is to build on the Introduction to Intensive Interaction training day, draw attention to good practice

and refine the practitioner's interactive skills, rather than concentrating on the learner's.

The Intensive Interaction Reflection Tool [Williamson & Barber 2007] will be used as the basis of discussion and analysis of video that participants have brought. Instruction and protocols for guiding professional reflection and organising safe group feedback sessions will be introduced, along with resources and skills which will enable participants can take this process back to their workplace to develop their own community of practitioners

If participants wish to take part in feedback sessions they are requested to bring a 10 minute video [on either DVD or flash drive] of themselves and a learner engaged in Intensive Interaction. NB please ensure that the practitioner is clearly visible in the video

This training is an established practice in over 30 schools and agencies in Australia and New Zealand. It has transformed the way Intensive Interaction is understood and practiced. If you want to get the most benefit from the training, bring some video of yourself - I can bring my video of practitioners but I can assure you that you learn best when you use your own video.
