We will also consider the impact of domestic abuse specifically on children with learning disabilities.

This seminar will be looking at:

- ◆ how best to support children and adults with learning disabilities and their families, using case material to illustrate
- ◆ the link between domestic abuse and learning disabilities using research findings
- ◆ the therapeutic approaches and assessment tools that inform our work with children who've experienced domestic abuse
- ◆ a recent High Court Judgement involving the forced marriage of a woman with learning disabilities, and learn more about the challenges presented by these cases
- ◆ how cases of forced marriage involving victims with a learning disability can differ from more conventional cases of forced marriage
- ◆ the importance of a victim-centred approach to cases, and striking the right balance between safeguarding and choice
