
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All Together Better

A national course bringing together family carers, people who work in social care, health services, education, leisure and other providers.



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What's All Together Better about?

All Together Better is a new national course that will identify, train, support and sustain a national network of champions in Personalisation.

All Together Better is a tailor-made programme based on Partners in Policymaking™, a proven, highly successful family leadership development programme.

Aimed at family carers and people who work in social care, health services, education and leisure, the course is about building new alliances that will become powerful and make real differences to the future of vulnerable people.

The course will:

- provide information and build participants' skills so that they gain the knowledge and confidence they need to campaign and advocate for a better future for vulnerable people
- build on work already done through investing in parent/carer leadership
- contribute to more effective partnership working
- incorporate all the key elements of our leadership development courses.

A strong values base of inclusion and equality underpins the programme. Participants will be listening, learning, planning and creating together.

Who should apply?

There will be 45 participants. Applications are invited from people who have first-hand experience of issues that affect disabled people.

When we use the term disabled, we are including people with learning disabilities, people with sensory or physical impairments and people who use mental health services. We also welcome applications from people who support older people, or people with long term illnesses.

All Together Better, will create a national network of champions in Personalisation, a network of people who think that life could be better for those who need extra support and who want to improve the way things are now – but don't always know where to start.
