### **The Project**

Surrey County Council's Service Delivery Team currently provides services and support to approximately 1200 people in a variety of day opportunities and supported accommodation options. Our Personalisation Project will begin with an initial 18 months programme of work, enabling groups of people who use in-house services to undertake supported self-assessments, take up personal budgets and, alongside community support brokers, plan the support they need. You'll work in partnership with people who use services, their families, advocates and support networks, as well as with council colleagues in Service Delivery, Commissioning and Personal Care and Support. This project is at the frontier of the Personalisation programme, which enables people to have their voices heard and support services and communities to develop and grow.

### **The Posts**

We are recruiting a range of posts to ensure this team can be effective, innovative and well supported. A Practitioner Level 2 Team Leader will provide skilled support to a team of up to eight Practitioners Level 1 and Assistant Practitioners Level 1 and 2. Practitioners of all grades will be free to focus on their person-led assessment and support planning work with people with learning

disabilities and older people. They'll be assisted by a dedicated admin team who'll provide valuable support with scheduling, recording and reporting. You'll receive bespoke training and support to enable you to develop and consolidate your social care practice and achieve great outcomes.
