Who is the course for?

People with learning difficulties, their family members, carers and professionals that work with them.

Course objectives:

- For a person with a learning disability to begin developing their own multimedia profile with a facilitator over the duration of the course.
- For delegates to learn technical and practical skills in using multimedia as a tool for advocacy, life coaching and communication.
- To involve a range of key people in the media and information gathering process.

About the course:

The courses will be held in the South East, North East and Cambridge. There will be 5 full day sessions run over a 10 week period. The cost of the course and package is £400 + VAT per focus person and facilitator. Discounted rates for families and volunteers £350 + VAT.
