Creative Communication training aims to provide delegates' with an understanding of the skills needed to implement the different techniques of **Creative Communication**.

- Interactive communication training for anyone working with, for, or on behalf of people with PMLD.
- An experiential workshop that covers a range of alternative communication methods and gives an insight of the difficulties faced when using them.
- Gives people a variety of creative methods to use to stimulate, interact with and gain the attention of people with PMLD.
- Guidance on how to "listen" to and try to understand people who do not use traditional communication methods.
- Emphasises the importance of choice, advocacy, communication and the responsibility we have to enable all people with learning disabilities to have these rights.
- Stimulates discussion and empower delegates to have the confidence to use their pre existing skills.

The day aims to bring to the attention of the delegates the ideas, theories and practical skills needed to use **Creative Communication** when working with, working for or interacting with people with PMLD. Following the training session delegates should be able to demonstrate and apply alternative and creative methods of communication in order to allow effective communication with people with PMLD.
