TRAINING COURSE 2009

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Big Ears is looking for people to champion Multimedia Profiling as a valuable tool for people with intellectual disabilities. Commissioned by Orchard Hill College in Surrey; we are providing an in-depth course in working with multimedia profiles. The course will be split into four different groups with 10 participants in each. The content of the course will cover both the values and approaches used in Multimedia Profiling as well as relevant technical knowledge.

TARGET GROUP

Lecturers, Teaching Aids and other relevant college staff, all professionals or others working to support people with intellectual disabilities in a person centred way.

AIMS

- To give participants insight into the benefits of using Multimedia Profiles with people with intellectual disabilities
- To promote the inclusion and empowerment of people with intellectual disabilities through the use of Multimedia and Person Centred Planning
- To engage a range of different professionals within the learning disabilities sector in using the Big Ears approach to Multimedia Profiling using our templates and materials
- For participants to work alongside people with disabilities throughout the course to help facilitate their own multimedia profiles
- To provide participants with the technical skills that will enable them to facilitate and champion Multimedia Profiles in their workplace

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course participants will have:

 An understanding of the benefits of using Multimedia Profiles

- Experience in facilitating and developing a person's Multimedia Profile
- A sound technical understanding of various multimedia processes, including using the Big Ears templates and resources and developing skills in advanced PowerPoint and various multimedia editing applications
- An understanding of how to evaluate the process and measure the success of a Multimedia Profile
- Good understanding of the facilitation of a person's profile including the involvement of family, friends and other service professionals
- Refreshed their understanding of the values of inclusion
- A set of Big Ears materials on a DVD ROM including; templates, manuals and other resources to use within their workplace*

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

This is an intermediate to advanced Multimedia Profiling course so participants should have good basic IT skills as a pre-requisite. We would also require participants to have a sound understanding of person centred practice and approaches.

Participants will also need to bring:

- Their own digital camera with video and sound capabilities.
