from your arm.



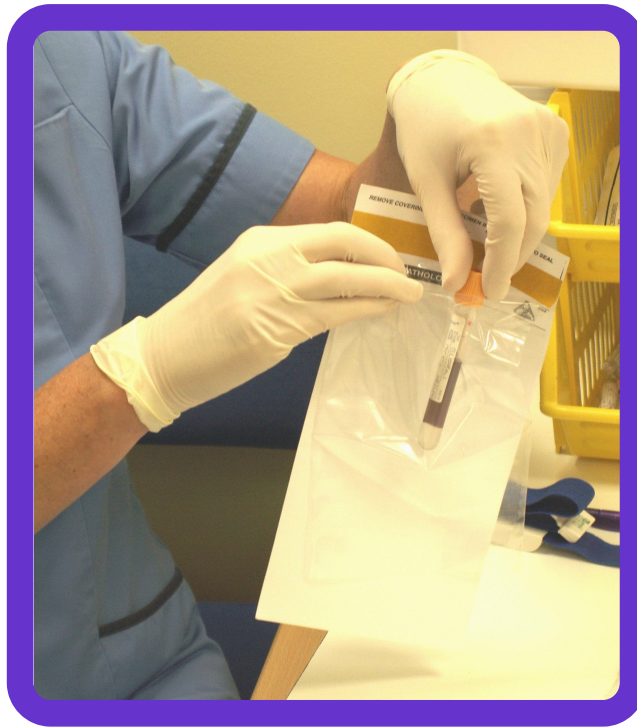
You hold a piece of cotton wool on your arm.
