The programme is ideal for you if you are working in offender services: prisons, young offender institutions, approved premises, probation, police service, secure accommodation, and other.

The foundation degree is designed so you will:

- Think more critically about your roles and the environments in which you work;
- Become more effective in working with people you are employed to serve;
- Review your knowledge and understanding of a range of national and international issues related to offender services;
- Develop skills and abilities to undertake agreed projects that will be of value to you and the service you are delivering;
- Gain an appreciation of current and contextual issues affecting offender services;
- Agree your own learning and assessment plans;
- Be taught by academic staff and practitioners, thus ensuring a more meaningful approach in offender services;

- Have the opportunity to progress to the final stage of a B.A. (Honours) Degree.

The programme is part-time and is delivered in evening classes, over three years. It follows the working year so that it fits into your working life in a manageable way. As the programme has a high level of work-based learning, both you and your service will benefit from your participation.
