and register before 13 July, by putting in your email address where indicated.

Almost immediately, you will get a message back saying your registration is pending. That message comes from messenger@webex.com, so if that doesn't come, it's because it's gone into your spam. You need to get that address cleared through your spam, because the confirmation of your registration with your personal joining links for the sound and vision elements of the webinar, comes from that address, too.

Once your registration is approved, you will receive a confirmation email with instructions for joining the session. You will be able to join the session from 10.45 am onwards, and you only need to use the toll-free phone instructions just before the start – 10.55 would be fine. A phone line with a speaker button would enable more than one person to participate and you can project it onto a bigger screen if you like; *but please don't use a mobile phone.*

Testing your equipment in advance
