Can you name an organisation that has trained 250 Inspectors in making information easier to understand?

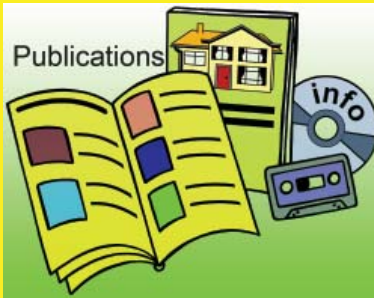
CHANGE (v) chaynj - become or make something different



In 1999 CHANGE produced the Picture Bank CD Rom of 500 images that can be used to make information easier to understand. The CD Rom was produced by people with learning disabilities and is even more popular today than it was in 1999.



In 2005 CHANGE met with then Minister for Children Margaret Hodge to find a way of enabling the DoH and the DFES to work together around issues that affect parents with learning disabilities.



CHANGE is at the forefront of employing people with learning disabilities to develop and run it's projects. Paid on equal scales to non disabled staff the experience and expertise of the learning disabled workers supports CHANGE to continue to develop as an exemplary rights organisation.



In 2006 CHANGE has trained 250 Inspectors for the Commission For Social Care Inspection in producing information that is easy to understand. CHANGE also produced a specific CD Rom for the CSCI.
