What is the CPA?

The Care Programme Approach (CPA) was introduced in 1991 by the Department of Health. It is a way of making sure that you get the health and social care you need and do not lose contact with services.

Who is the CPA for?

It is for people with Learning Disabilities who:-

- Have mental health problems (Dual Diagnosis)
- Are admitted to specialist learning disability or mental health inpatient services
- Have or are likely to commit an offence (Offending Behaviour)
- Are a risk to themselves or other people (Challenging Behaviour)

How does the CPA work?

1 Assessment – brings together everyone

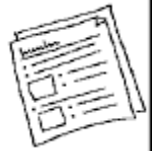

2 Care Plan – makes sure that you and your carer are involved in writing a plan of care that says who is doing what.



3 CPA Care Co-ordinator – someone is identified who you know and who knows what your needs are.

4 CPA Reviews – bring everyone together to make sure that your Care Plan is meeting your needs.
