It will highlight the benefits and quality of life that can be achieved through Personalised Technology, and how this approach can be cost-effective for service providers.

We will look at the different types of assistive technology available, and explore how these technologies can be used to support people with a learning disability in all areas of their lives - at home, work, education and leisure.

This event offers you the opportunity to find out more about the increasing range of Personalised Technology (PT) available and discuss the issues affecting access to their use in Wales. It will place the discussion in the context of the Social Services and Well-being (Wales) Bill and the Framework for Action on Independent Living.

The conference comes at a time when service providers and commissioners are increasingly having to provide services with weakened budgets, while planning ahead to meet the needs of an ageing population. Independence through Personalised Technology will explore how the person-centred use of technology can address these challenges.

- how support providers can implement and use technology in a person-centred way
- the ethical issues of implementing and using assistive technology
- staff development
