This course will enable you to target your learning with a focus on your own field of practice whether Learning Disability, Child Health or Adult.

This online course will be delivered using innovative technologies to allow face to face access to lecturers and practitioners. This gives you the flexibility to study at a time and place which suits you.

The course will consist of three x 20 credit modules:

1. Diagnosis and management of epilepsy
2. Psychosocial management
3. Work based learning which allows you to explore aspects of epilepsy within your practice
