

## EMIS Template Installation Instructions

### *Learning Disabilities Template*

**WARNING:** Before installing any new templates, you must check that you do not already have a template with the same name or clinical term. If you do, the template you import will merge with the existing template.

#### 1. Check for existing templates

Main menu **DT**, then **C**, then **E**, then select line label letter for Templates.

**IF THERE ARE TEMPLATES WITH THE SAME NAME AS THE ONES YOU ARE ABOUT TO INSTALL DO NOT PROCEED. PLEASE CONTACT DECISION SUPPORT FOR FURTHER ADVICE.**

#### 2. Create a Learning Disabilities File within the main Template file

Placing the template together under a general Learning Disabilities file will make it easier to find and will keep your main template file uncluttered. You will need a code for 'Learning Disabilities'

**DT**, then **C**, then **E**, then select line label letter for Templates

Press **1** to add a template

Choose the empty line label you wish the Learning Disabilities file to occupy.

Enter the code **918e**

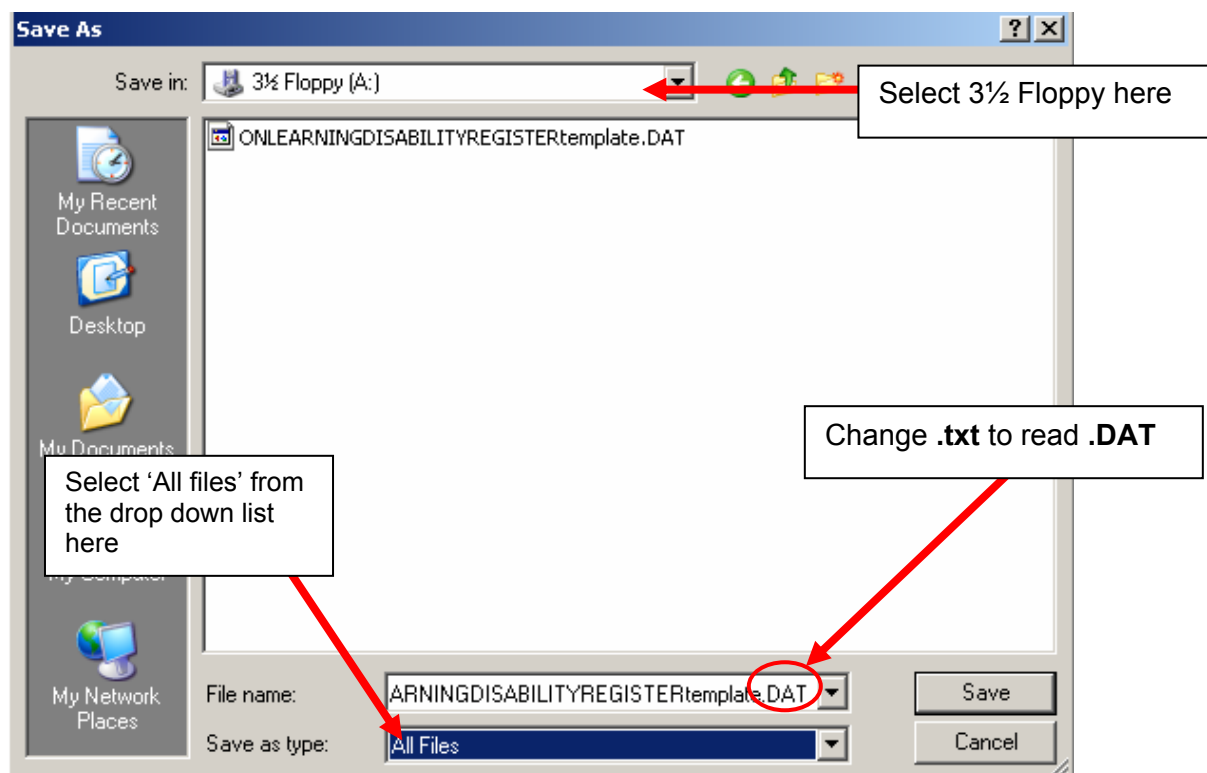
Select **On Learning disability register** line then **enter**

Type **H** pointer to lower hierarchical level

Learning Disabilities file now occupies the line label you selected

#### 3. Download Templates from Website

Insert floppy disk and go to the website <http://www.oxmaag.co.uk/>. Click on templates button (LHS of screen) then Learning Disabilities. **Right** click on the green arrow by the template you wish to download. Select **Save target as** then



Click Save.

When download is complete click Close.

You now need to load the template into EMIS, as follows

#### 4. Load floppy disk containing template into server

Main menu

**CO** Communications menu

**TT** Template transfer

**B** Import templates to the floppy disk drive

Select **A: TEMPLATE.DAT** and change to

**A:ONLEARNINGDISABILITYREGISTERtemplate.DAT**

Press return.

#### 5. Place templates from hard disk on to access screen

Main menu

**DT**, then **C** then **E** then **select line label letter for Templates** followed by line label letter for **Learning Disabilities** (this is the one you created earlier)

Press **1** to replace or cancel

Select empty line label to add to

Type suggested code **918e** then select **918e** On Learning Disability Register

Select **T** (to allow to be a title for a template)

Title will now appear on the line label you selected in the Learning Disabilities Template file

The template is now ready to use.
