

# ADHD in Custody and Beyond the Gates

**Wednesday 14 May 2014**

The Met Hotel, King Street, Leeds LS1 2HQ

ADHD has been demonstrated to be significantly over represented throughout the criminal justice system. Within the prison settings, rates of around 15% are reported, and those with ADHD account for increased critical incidents within the prison environment. In recent years, prison mental health services have reported a steep increase in referrals for prisoners with suspected ADHD, although this is still felt to be the tip of the iceberg. The assessment of ADHD in the custodial environment, provision of effective treatment and continuity of treatment following release from prison, has created a number of challenges including the high prevalence of comorbidity, the restrictions of the environment and the limited resources.

At this conference we will consider the association between ADHD and the criminal justice system based on the most recent evidence. We will present strategies for assessing and treating prisoners with ADHD in different prison environments. We will also discuss how prison ADHD services may be best provided and how support may look after release.
