### EVENING STUDY GROUP

From October 2012 to March 2013

Respond is running a three term study group on Monday evenings (5:30 – 7.00pm) spread over 5 evenings per term. Respond clinicians will introduce and lead discussions based around key papers and chapters related to people with learning disabilities in relation to psychotherapy, sexual abuse, sexual offending, and attachment and loss.

### FEES

**Seminars** cost £50 or £40 if booked more than 3 weeks in advance. The **Evening Study Group** costs £125/term or £350 if booking on all three terms.
