

Health and Disability: Partnerships in Action

A learning and teaching resource in disability health and interprofessional education

Thank you for your interest in 'Health and Disability: Partnerships in Action', a digital learning and teaching package produced by the Centre for Developmental Disability Health Victoria (CDDHV).

The CDDHV was established within the Faculty of Medicine Nursing and Health Sciences, Monash University, to improve the health and health care of people with developmental disabilities.

'Health and Disability: Partnerships in Action' has been produced through an interprofessional collaboration between the CDDHV and health professionals from dentistry, dietetics, health science, medicine, nursing, occupational therapy, paramedic practice, physiotherapy, social work and speech pathology.

The package comprises 6-DVD based video stories, Study Guides and Knowledge Base, and focuses on:

- **Disability health**: exploring issues in the health and health care of people with developmental disabilities, including intellectual disability, cerebral palsy and autism spectrum disorders.
- Interprofessional education and practice: providing a platform for interprofessional education and a springboard for appreciating the value and importance of interprofessional practice.

Video stories: Six DVDs, each focusing on the personal story of someone with a disability, form the heart of this package. The close collaboration between those featured and the video stories and the health professionals has been integral to the development of this powerful resource. Each story runs for between 13 and 20 minutes, and is also divided into short clips to highlight key issues. Each DVD includes a booklet insert containing learning objectives, learning activities and sample responses for that story.

Study Guides: A Student Workbook, containing synopses and the learning activities for all six stories, has been developed to support and enhance learning and teaching opportunities. In addition to the contents of the Student Workbook, the Tutor Guide also contains sample responses for each of the learning activities.



The **Knowledge Base** is a 272 page full-colour illustrated textbook.
