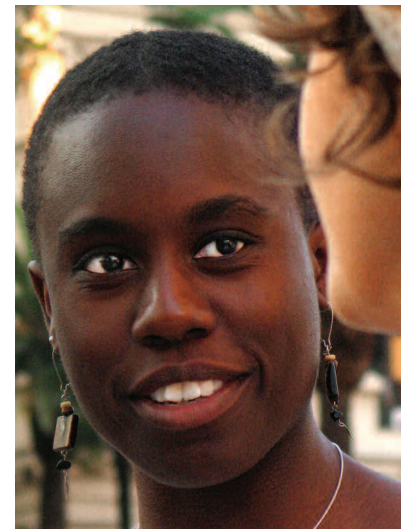

This day will examine the human rights of people with learning disabilities from minority communities. It will consider the dehumanising effect of multiple discrimination. It will highlight the differing attitudes to life experiences. By the end of the day delegates will have a clear knowledge of human rights and accompanying legislation. They will understand their duty within that and how to ensure learning disability services respect and deliver on human rights - this will include areas of extreme sensitivity and enable practitioners to feel confident in challenging what is wrong, but supporting activities that will enhance a person's life within their cultural expectations.



**Bridget Fisher** is currently involved in managing several projects involving minority communities including leading the 'Moving on Up' team and the CAMHS project on Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services. Bridget also manages ARC's Consultancy Service for Learning Disability Partnership Boards on implementing change to improve services for minority communities and is also the author of several publications.
