

Most people with learning disabilities have greater needs than the rest of the population. They are more likely to develop mental illness and are more prone to chronic health problems and sensory and physical disabilities.

It can affect people of all ages, regardless of occupation or background and is one of the top three causes of sickness absence.

“IMAGINE YOU ARE ME” is an innovative new eLearning module developed by Bluestream Learning in collaboration with Sheffield Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust. It's Aim is to raise the awareness of the needs of people with learning disabilities and are either attending hospital or are having an inpatient episode of care.

This module covers such areas as:

## Mental health

- Issues faced by people with mental illness
- Therapies
- Stereotyping and discrimination



## Learning disabilities

- Key standards in support of person centred planning and assessment of care, e.g. Individual Care Planning, Flexibility, Link Person, Audit of Service etc.
- Sensory impairment
- Mobility disability
- Carers



The program uses a combination of text, images, video sequences and interactive questions to engage the trainee and covers a variety of different principles of care including: visual impairment, hearing impairment, mobility disability and mental health problems.

After completing the training, the user will be able to demonstrate good understanding of legislation and identify the needs of a person with a learning disability.
