<p><b>JANE MOORE</b> Oxleas Foundation Trust</p> <p>Winner - HSJ 2007 Awards: Implementing NICE Guidance</p>	<p><b>Implementation Support Tool for Schizophrenia</b></p> <p>This project implements NICE guidance on schizophrenia across a London-based mental health trust. The project included comprehensive involvement of service users and had been one of the board’s top priorities. It had produced a model which gained clinical engagement and was replicable across a geographically diverse site.</p>
<p><b>OPINDA SAHOTA</b> Nottingham University Hospitals Trust</p> <p>Finalist – HSJ 2007 Awards: Implementing NICE Guidance</p>	<p><b>The Nottingham Fracture Liaison Project</b></p> <p>The project set up bone and falls risk assessment for all patients aged 50 and over presenting to an outpatient fracture clinic or as an inpatient with low trauma fractures, in a bid to reduce fractures suffered. Implementation is conducted by a fracture liaison clerk. Those aged over 70 are offered a bone density scan and high-risk patients are referred to a metabolic clinic.</p>
<p><b>KYLIE FARBRACE</b> North East Lincolnshire CTP</p> <p>Finalist – HSJ 2007 Awards: Implementing NICE Guidance</p>	<p><b>HOPE for the Future</b></p> <p>The Health Optimisation, Prevention and Education (HOPE) service offers a one-stop shop for people with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and at a risk of falls. Work with the local authority is under way to develop a functional rehabilitation zone that will help people at risk of falls learn to cope with obstacles outdoors.</p>
<p><b>PETER DICKSON</b> Bradford and Airedale Teaching PCT</p> <p>Highly Commended - HSJ 2007 Awards: Implementing NICE Guidance</p>	<p><b>Improving Local Outcomes for People with Skin Cancer</b></p> <p>Informed of wide variations in the removal of skin cancer lesions by GPs, the PCT local lead clinician and skin cancer team supported a skin cancer review. An implementation package was developed, which included a local skin cancer pathway, guidelines and comprehensive education package for primary care clinicians. Over 75 per cent of local GP practices have now attended.</p>
<p><b>ESTHER WHITTEN</b> Sandwell Mental Health and Social Care Trust</p> <p>Finalist – HSJ 2007 Awards: Implementing NICE Guidance</p>	<p><b>Implementing NICE Epilepsy Guidelines in a Learning Disability Service</b></p> <p>This service provides patients and carers to have their epilepsy needs addressed by a doctor and epilepsy nurse specialist at a specialised clinic. Previously people who had been seen as outpatients, along with those attending mental health diagnoses at a generic clinic, did not have the time to focus on epilepsy needs.</p>
