This training event will enable you to ensure that people with a learning disability are included in your organisation, service or place of worship. People with a learning disability make up about 2% of the population and are increasingly using community activities and services rather than segregated provision for people with a learning disability as we now recognise that they 'want a life not a service'. This event will enable you to be more aware of their support needs and other relevant issues, and so provide a place of welcome.

Learning Outcomes

- Understand the nature and characteristics of learning disability
- Understand the impact of having the label of learning disability
- Understand what types of support people with learning disabilities need and the best way this can be delivered
- Understand key legislation and guidance concerning the lives of people with learning disabilities
- Understand some of the barriers to inclusion and how to overcome them
- Know where to get further resources

The training is delivered by Building Bridges Training through a mixture of presentations, personal stories from the first-hand experience of the trainers and group activities. Handouts are provided to support the training session, and a certificate of attendance will be given at the end of the course.

This training event is for anyone who wants to include people with a learning disability in their organisation, service or place of worship. It assumes only minimal previous contact with people with a learning disability.

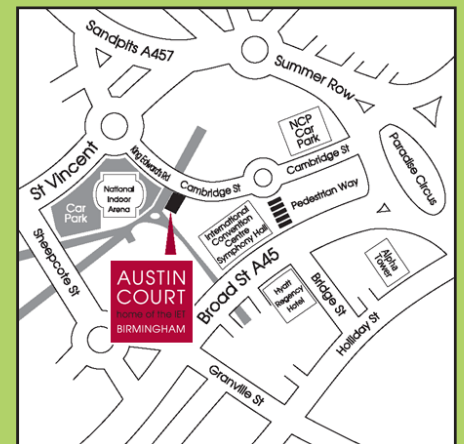
Venue and Event details
