The use of mechanical devices in the physical restraint of people who have learning disabilities

This one day conference will specifically address issues associated with the use of mechanical restraint within services for children, young people and adults who have a learning disability. The use of mechanical restraint, in services for people with learning disability and /or autistic spectrum disorder falls broadly within the following categories:

- Advanced planning as part of a behavioural support strategy
- As part of a therapeutic intervention
- Reactively to reduce risk to the individual and/or others as a result of their Behaviour

Oliver et al (1987) stated that 13% of people with learning disabilities who exhibit self injurious behaviour wore protective devices or experienced mechanical restraint. While Emerson (2002) suggests – 5% of children & 7% of adults with self injurious behaviour and challenging behaviour sometimes or usually have experienced the use of mechanical restraint as a method of behaviour management.

This conference will not consider or discuss the use of mechanical restraint as an emergency intervention.

Aims of the day:

- To define what a mechanical restraint is
- To explore policy and guidance issues
- To highlight principles for best practice and disseminate principles for practice
- To discuss case studies and consider appropriate strategies
