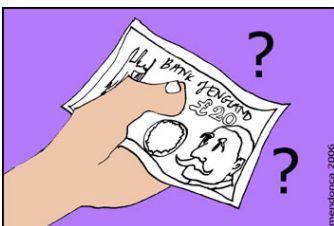
## Where?
