




Form to apply for a job at Mencap




Checking the information that you give us

- Mencap has the right to check any information you give us at any time.



- If you sign this form it means you agree that we can check the information you give us if we need to.



Keeping the information you give us safe

- We will keep the information you give us on this form private and safe. We will only use it to help us choose the best person for the job.

- If you start working for us we might sometimes need to look at or use the information you give us.



- If this happens we will make sure we follow the law about keeping information safe. This is called the Data Protection Act.



If you sign this form it means you are happy for us to sometimes use the information you give us on this form but only in the right way.

All the information you have given us is right and true as far as you know.

If you have given us wrong information or not told us something important that we need to know

- you might not be able to get a job with us
- you might have to leave your job if you already work here.




If we offer you a job, we will ask you for the details of 2 people you know. This is called getting references. It is so we can find out more about you.



If we offer you a job, you will have to work with us for a trial period first. This means that the first 6 months of the job will be about making sure that you and your manager are happy that the job is right for you.





You might also have to go to the doctor to get your health checked if Mencap asks you to.



If we offer you the job and you will be working closely with people with a learning disability, you might need a **criminal record check**.

This is a check to make sure you have not been in trouble with the police in a way that could affect your job.



The check is done by a group called the Criminal Records Bureau Disclosure Service for England and Wales or from Access NI if you are in Northern Ireland.
