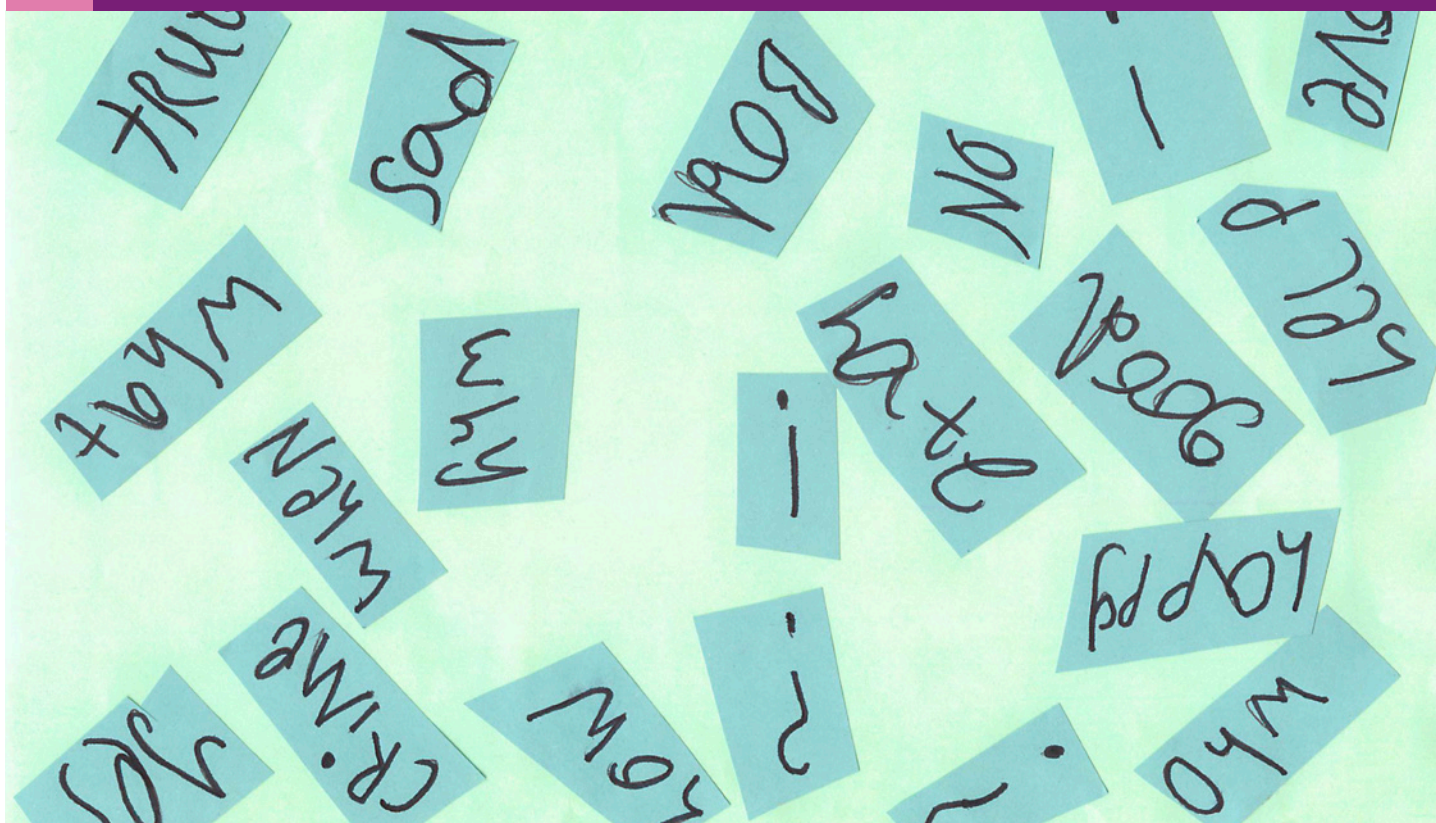


Children and adolescents with development disabilities conference

The theme of this conference is the specialist medico-legal and forensic needs of children and young people with developmental disabilities. There will be a focus on understanding the role of specialist services and how assessment and intervention might be offered. Issues about service development will be considered, as well as the management of risk.

The conference is particularly aimed at professionals including psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers, youth offending teams and teachers who work in the field of mental health of developmental disability. Renowned experts, some of whom lead the developmental neuropsychiatry and neuropsychology service at the Maudsley Hospital, will present on a range of topics.
