SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION – FORMAT DESCRIPTIONS



Plenary lectures

A keynote presentation will take 45 minutes. Keynote speakers are chosen in recognition of their achievements.

Symposium

Symposia take 1,5 hour, and are composed of max. 4 paper presentations and at least 30 minutes for discussion. A collection of max. 4 papers presenting the results of different studies on a common research topic or developing a theoretical/practical key concept or a new model.

Paper Symposia

Paper symposia take 1,5 hour and are composed of 2-4 paper presentations, clustered as much as possible according the topic. There will be at least 30 minutes for discussion.

Poster Presentation

A printed illustrated summary of a presentation to be posted among a collection of similarly themed posters. EAMHID considers posters to be as important as oral papers and there will be dedicated poster slots scheduled into the congress programme. Poster will be attended

by at least one author who can address questions related to the posters content to interested delegates.

Workshop Session

Workshop Session take 1,5 hour and can be composed by:

- 2 different or related workshops;
- 1 workshop and 1 or 2 individual papers on the same subject.

Each workshop take 45 minutes which allows participants to acquire and practice skills or to work together on common problems.

- · Strategies to encourage participants' active involvement in the session are clearly defined.
- Workshops are not lectures or panels, but rather presentations that include audience participation structured into the activity as discussion, hands-on demonstration, evaluation, etc.

Round Table

A 60 minutes discussion between representatives of organizations involved in mental health issues in IDD.
