Making information and communication easier to understand



This training event will enable you to improve your communication with people with learning disabilities and enable them to have good access to information. The training will cover verbal communication, written information, communication in meetings and public signage.

Learning Outcomes

- Understand how to improve verbal communication with people with a learning disability
- Understand the difference between plain English and Easy Read, and how to make letters and written information easier to understand with the use of easy words and pictures and good design and layout
- Understand how to run meetings where people with a learning disability can understand what is going on and can contribute
- Understand the particular needs of people with high individual communication needs, and people with sensory impairments

The training is delivered by Building Bridges Training through a mixture of presentations, personal stories from the first-hand experience of the trainers and group activities. Handouts are provided to support the training session, and a certificate of attendance will be given at the end of the course.

This training event is for anyone who wants to improve communication with people with a learning disability in their organisation or service. Previous contact with people with a learning disability is not essential.

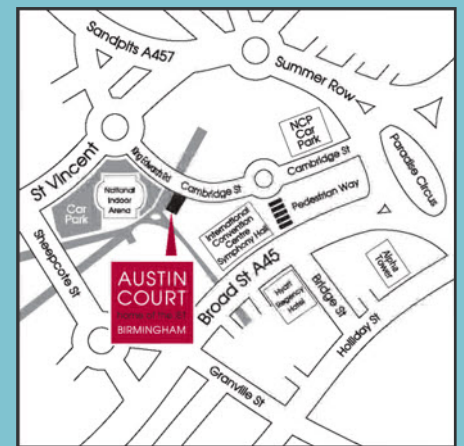
Venue and Event details
