

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must be a practising health or social care practitioner with a BSc (Hons) or equivalent professional experience. Degree-equivalent qualifications will be considered, as will appropriate experience gained in the pharmaceutical or healthcare industries.

If you are an international student you will be required to demonstrate an English Language Level of IELTS 5.5 or equivalent upon entry.

- Eight options from a wide range of health, life and social science modules.


CAREER PROSPECTS
