Quality Assurance Reviewers

The Nursing and Midwifery Council is an organisation set up by Parliament to protect the public by ensuring that nurses and midwives provide high standards of care to their patients and clients.

Mott MacDonald has been delivering educational quality assurance on behalf of the NMC since 2006 /7.

We are seeking to recruit a number of reviewers from both nursing practice and education in the field of learning disabilities nursing.

The reviewers will be involved in programme approval ensuring that the new NMC standards for nursing education are met and programme monitoring, ensuring that programmes are delivered in a manner that meets statutory requirements and enables students to achieve the required outcomes and proficiencies. Reviewers will be paid a fee for carrying out quality assurance and will be required to commit to up to 15 days per annum to these activities.
