BME Family Carers Day 19th February 2009

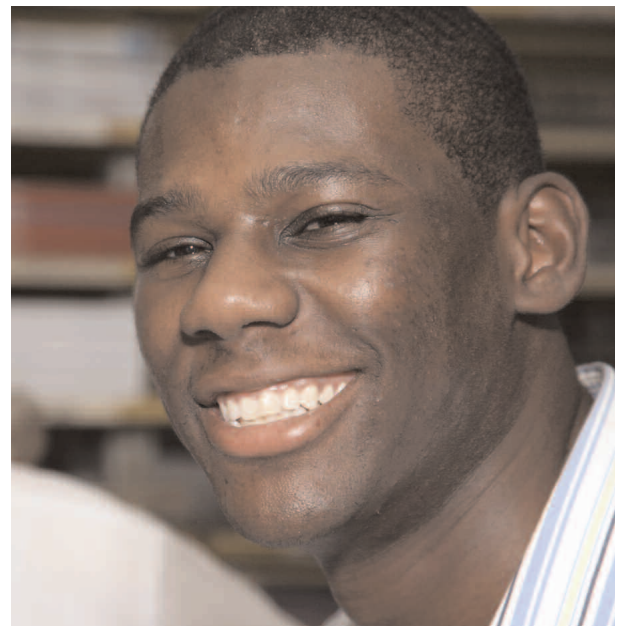
