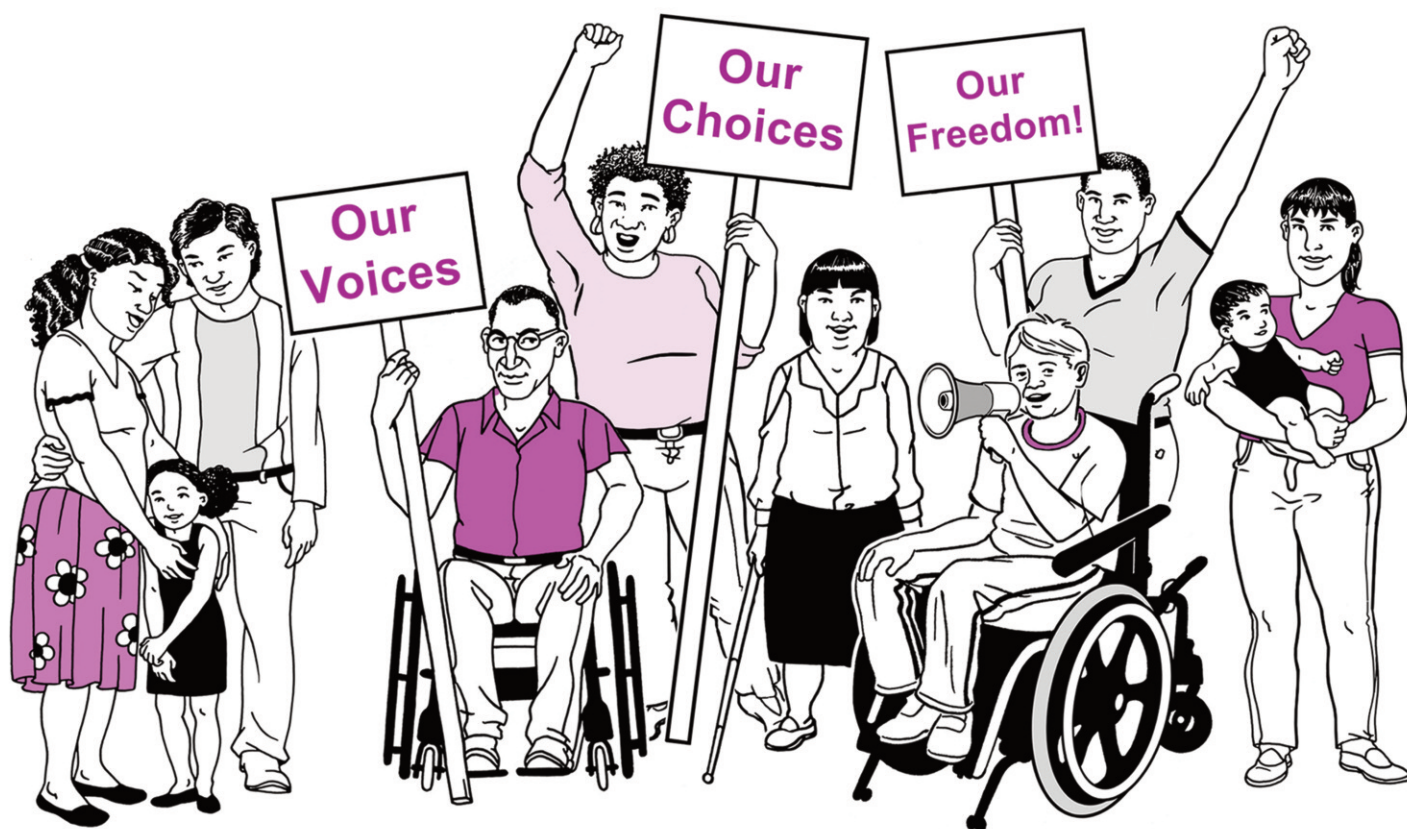

Norman Lamb, Minister of State, Department of Health, will be there!



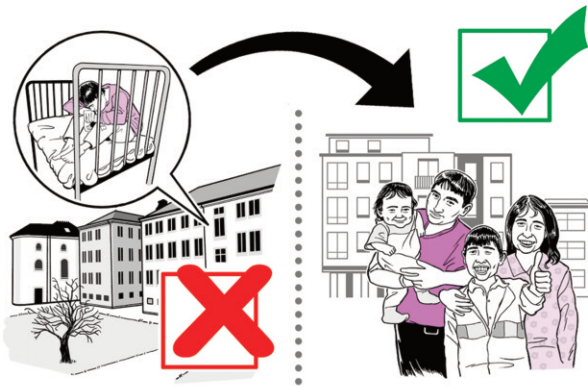
