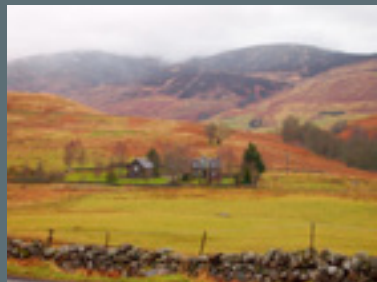
'The power of the photographic images presented by the Shifting Perspectives team, continues to support the work of the Down's Syndrome Association.
