Person Centred Planning is a great way to help young people plan for their futures and make the best out of all the changes happening in their lives.

Course Aims

This course will help you improve the life experiences of young people in “transition” between the ages of 14 and 19.

Person Centred Planning (PCP) is a set of approaches designed to assist someone plan their life.

This one day course looks how transition can impact young people, and how you can incorporate PCP into your own practice. Reflecting upon the experiences of the Real Opportunities Project working with young people, families and professionals, you will learn how to overcome some of the difficulties faced around transition.

Course includes

- the history of Person Centred Planning
- how PCP complements the transition process
- statutory reform
- how PCP will be used within the new Individual Development Plans.

Through group work and discussion the course will give participants the opportunity to try out some PCP tools and activities. It will also give you the chance to look at how to create a one page profile.
