Situated in Wateringbury, Kent, within easy commute of Maidstone, Tonbridge Wells, and Hastings and with direct transport links to Central London, the South Coast and East Sussex, Pelican Court is a well established two storey property offering substantial accommodation in comfortable surroundings, with easily accessible and well equipped grounds.

Rated as a 2 Star 'Good' Service by CQC, the service provides support to adults with learning disabilities who may have associated complex health needs.

As a service providing specialist support to people with a diagnosis of epilepsy, dysphasia, sensory impairments or other associated diagnosis' we work in close partnership with West Kent's local community learning disability team, the Community Nurse and other specialist health professionals, to deliver a fully trained staff team competent and experienced in a wide range of person-specific interventions.

As part of our commitment to an holistic approach to service delivery, we liaise closely with a wide range of external professional services including

neuro-psychologists, psychiatrists, dentists, epilepsy nurses, dieticians, sensory teams, physiotherapists and speech and language therapists to develop and implement robust health and support action plans centred around the promotion of health & well being.
