Project Coordinator
(£32,000 pro rata Full Time)

Respond is establishing a Domestic Violence and Sexual Abuse project for children and young people with Learning Disabilities. The post will involve set up and project coordination, leading a team of three therapists, providing group therapy and external training.

You will need:

- Considerable project co-ordination experience
- A psychotherapy, counselling or arts therapy qualification
- At least 3 years experience of providing therapy to clients who have experienced domestic violence or sexual abuse, preferably children and young people
- Substantial experience of working with people with learning disabilities

Psychotherapist
(£30,000 pro rata 21 hours/week)

The post will work in Respond's new Domestic Violence and Sexual Abuse Project. It will involve providing individual and group therapy to young clients with learning disabilities. Non-clinical responsibilities include: delivering external training and an outreach programme.

You will need:

- At least 2 years experience of providing therapy to clients who have experienced domestic violence or sexual abuse, preferably children and young people
- A psychotherapy, counselling or arts therapy qualification
- Considerable experience of working with young people with learning disabilities

Case Manager / Family Worker
(£29,000 pro rata 10 hours/week)

Respond's *Psychotherapy in Schools* service for children and young people with learning disabilities requires a Case Manager / Family Worker to manage clinical work in a West London school. The post involves offering therapeutic work with families and the co-facilitation of 2 groups for young people.

You will need:

- Substantial experience of working with people with learning disabilities, preferably children and young people
- A psychotherapy, counselling or arts therapy qualification;
- At least 2 years experience of providing therapy to people with learning disabilities, preferably children and young people;
- Considerable experience of working with families, preferably of those with young people learning disabilities;
- To be available to work on Mondays and Fridays.
