CALL FOR RUNNERS AND VOLUNTEERS FOR THE BRITISH 10K RACE IN LONDON - 8 JULY 2012

The British 10K London Run is the UK's most prestigious 10km road race staged on one of the world's greatest routes through the heart of central London.

25,000 runners will fill the streets of the nation's capital and will have the unique opportunity to run past many of the world's most famous landmarks including Big Ben, The London Eye, St Paul's Cathedral, Trafalgar Square and Westminster Abbey. Runners of all abilities will be taking part, from charity fundraisers and recreational athletes, right through to Olympic champions. Almost anyone can run (or walk) 10k!

The 2012 event is staged just 19 days before the start of the Olympic Games and the excitement and buzz around London will make this year's run a truly special occasion.

As the official race charity, we are looking to enlist 2,012 runners to join Team Special Olympics Great Britain, each of whom will aim to raise £250 or more in sponsorship. Together, our target will be over £500,000.

These vital funds will enable Special Olympics GB to continue to deliver year round sports training and competition and, in doing so, positively change the lives of many of the 1.2 million children and adults with learning disabilities in Great Britain.
