The following document is being sent to you in response to your request for more information regarding our SOTSEC-ID training event.

Date and times:

The event is being held on the dates specified on the booking forms. It is a two day event which aims to start at 9:30am each day, finish by 4:30 on the first day, and around 3pm on the second day. Following the training on the second day the delegates are invited to attend the SOTSEC-ID business meeting that will last until around 4.30pm. This is optional, but a great opportunity for you to hear from other clinicians about their experiences and difficulties in running the groups.

Modules:

The training will cover the following modules:

- *CBT for men with learning disabilities at risk of sexual offending: previous groups and the role of SOTSEC-ID*
- *Therapeutic climate and getting started*
- *Sex education*
- *Victim empathy*
- *Cognitive approaches*
- *The four stage model of sexual offending*
- *Relapse prevention*
- *Risk assessment*
- *Assessment measures and evaluation of group outcome*
- *Putting it all together & the importance of giving men something to live for!*

Intended for:

The event is intended for training lead and co-facilitators. The lead facilitator should ideally have a background in clinical psychology or be a CBT trained therapist. The co-facilitators can be LD social workers, probation officers, community LD nurses or LD psychology assistants.

Cost of training:

Cost is dependent on the membership status of yourself/ your Trust. See the two options below

SOTSEC membership:
