In every classroom there are now four children who have been born prematurely.

In the last decade the numbers of children born prematurely (e.g. before 36 weeks) has risen rapidly, and now stands at around 80,000 children per year.

These children, as one parent said, are 'wired differently': their learning patterns can be quite different. Research is showing this is particularly so in areas such as mathematics.

Schools and teachers need to be prepared to face this significant challenge.

This conference, bringing together nationally and internationally renowned speakers from the fields of Psychology, Neuroscience and Education, aims to provide a dialogue around the learning needs of children born prematurely.

Outcomes for participants

- An appreciation of the neurodevelopmental needs of children born pre-term
- Up to date information around the neuroscience of this group of children
- Key information on the teaching and learning challenges presented by children born pre-term
- An opportunity to create a 'common language' of development through networking with colleagues from the field of education, psychology, therapies, nursing, medicine, paediatrics and the voluntary sector.
