The overall aims of the sponsorship:

- To enhance the role of the NNLDN in ensuring future learning disability nurses involvement.

Applications are invited from student nurses undertaking the learning or intellectual disability branch of nursing within the United Kingdom or Republic of Ireland.

All applicants must seek support for their application from their Personal Tutor (or equivalent)

Guidelines for Submission

Entries will **only** be accepted if they include a completed entry form. It is recognised that the emphasis of applications will vary according to the focus of individual initiatives; the following guidance offers suggestions for the content, presentation and structure of your application.

Entry form This is an essential part of the application; please ensure that it is legible and fully completed. You need to submit one form only along with your essay or equivalent.

Dissemination You need to submit an essay or equivalent of 1000 words on *“Could it happen here? Inclusion, Protection and Regulation”* and the role of the learning disability nurse.

References Include all literature referred to and/or relevant to the submission using your university referencing system.

Presentation Essay submissions must be typed using double-spacing on numbered, single sides of A4 paper or your preferred choice ensuring the equivalent of the word limits.
