

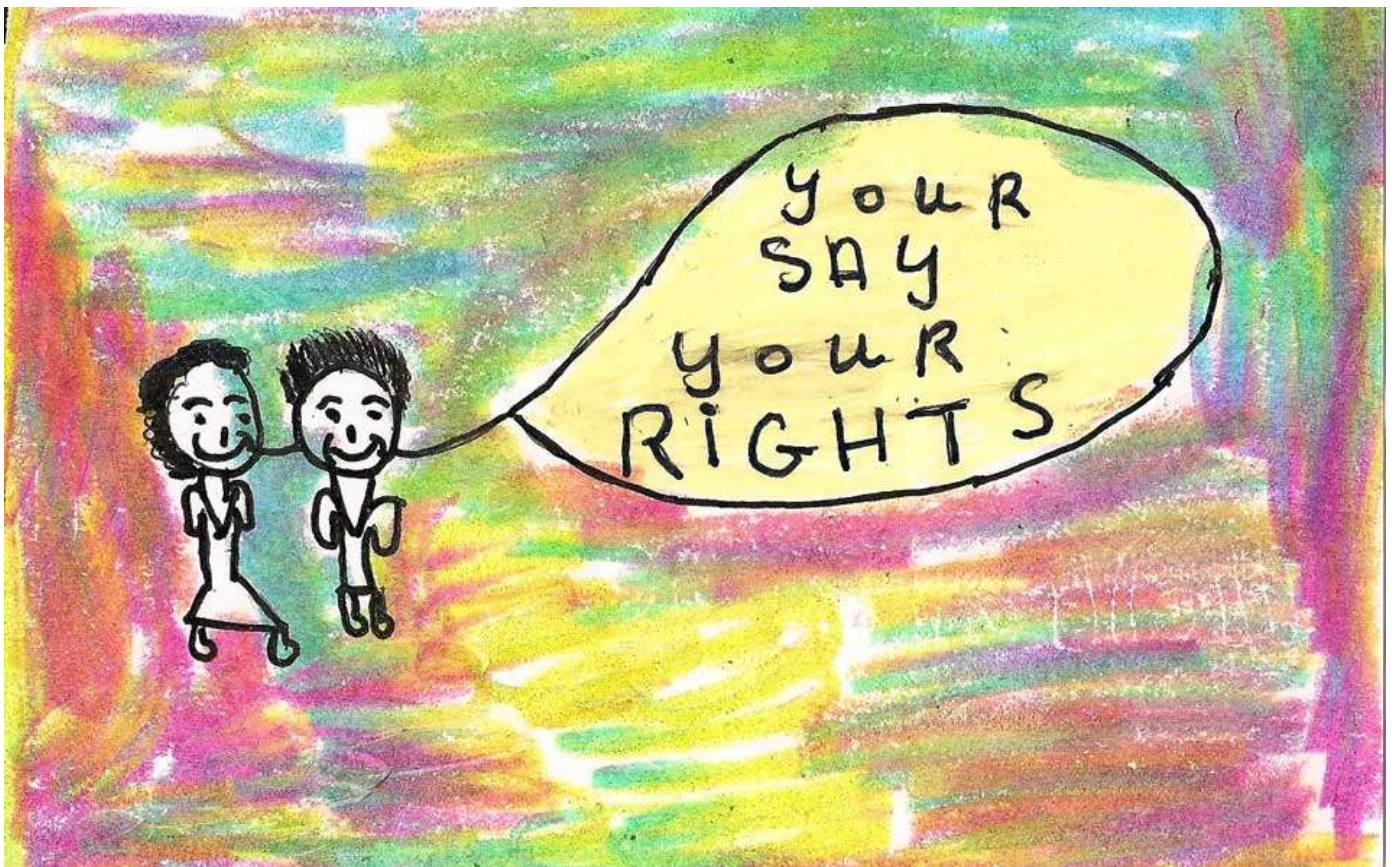

- We want people in Leinster to get together and talk about their human rights.



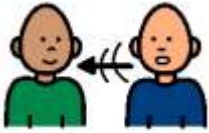
When is it on?
